FACTS

- One explosion near Sacramento, <u>displaced 140 people</u> in 2014
- Northern California burn centers have treated 68 people for BHO burns between 2011 and Sept 2014. The <u>average person was</u> <u>burned on 28% of the body</u>
- Five hash oil explosions occurred in Colorado during <u>one week</u> of 2014
- University Hospital Burn Unit, Colorado reported BHO burn victim statistics in December 2014:

-2014 = 16
-2013 = 11
-2012 = 1
```

-2011 = 1

 Los Angeles Times reports 17 people were treated in Southern California burn centers due to hash-oil explosions in a 14 month period, 2013-2014.

EXTREME CONSEQUENCES

The worst HASH OIL explosion was in Bellevue, WA November 5, 2013. The fire lasted 7 hours and took 100 firefighters and police to put it out. One woman died. All 10 apartments were destroyed, causing \$1.5 million in property damage and \$500,000 worth of belongings. Police had investigated 2 men living there 3 weeks earlier, but they showed their medical marijuana cards and said they did not make hash oil.
